

## DRESS GUIDELINES

<b>DRESSAGE &amp; RIDING TESTS</b> <b>(Including dressage phase of Horse Trials)</b>	
<b>Hat</b>	MUST wear a hard hat to at least the minimum standard, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Hats marked EN1384, PASO15:1998, ASTM F1163, BSEN14572:2005 or SEI. American standard SNELL E2001, ASTM 95, SNZ3838 1998. Skullcap hats must be worn with a silk
<b>Jodhpurs &amp; Breeches</b>	White, cream or beige breeches or jodhpurs
<b>Boots</b>	Plain black or brown which may also be top boots or jodhpur boots. The boots should be a traditional style. Gaiters may be worn providing they are of identical leather to the boots and have no decoration of any sort
<b>Jackets, Shirts &amp; Body Protectors</b>	Jacket may be dark blue or black with white stock. Tweed jacket with coloured stock or collar and tie. White stocks, white American collar or white shirts with collar and tie may be worn. Body protectors may be worn. If worn, it should be fitted and worn as per the manufacturers' guidelines.
<b>Hair &amp; Jewellery</b>	No jewellery or any items worn in facial or body piercings are permitted. Hair must be neatly secured and MUST not hang lower than the shoulder line when standing normally
<b>Gloves</b>	Gloves of a light colour SHOULD be worn
<b>Whips</b>	Whips for Dressage and Riding Tests must not exceed 110cm. May be used when riding in, at Area qualifiers but NOT at Championships (except when a rider has a BRC Dispensation letter) In Horse Trials Whips may NOT be carried at Area qualifiers or at Championships
<b>Spurs</b>	Spurs are NOT permitted in Riding Tests In Dressage spurs of excessively severe design may not be worn, such designs include spurs with necks set to inside of heel, spurs with roughened/cutting edges and serrated spurs with or without necks. Spurs with smooth rowels not exceeding 1cm are allowed. Spurs may only be worn in the traditional manner, with the curve, if any, of the neck of the spur directed downwards. Spurs are not compulsory for Medium Dressage

At the discretion of the judge, competitors may be permitted to ride without jackets in excessively hot weather, but a suitable shirt that fastens at the neck (not bright or multi-coloured with a tie). American collar or correctly fastened stock must be worn. Shirts must have long sleeves. Plain, dark coloured waterproof coats may be worn in wet weather

<b>SHOW &amp; STYLE JUMPING</b> <b>(Including show jumping phase of Horse Trials)</b>	
<b>Hat</b>	MUST wear a hard hat to at least the minimum standard, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Hats marked EN1384, PASO15:1998, ASTM F1163, BSEN14572:2005 or SEI. American standard SNELL E2001, ASTM 95, SNZ3838 1998. Skullcap hats must be worn with a silk
<b>Jodhpurs &amp; Breeches</b>	White, cream or beige breeches or jodhpurs
<b>Boots</b>	Plain black or brown which may also be top boots or jodhpur boots. The boots should be a traditional style. Gaiters may be worn providing they are of identical leather to the boots and have no decoration of any sort
<b>Jackets, Shirts &amp; Body Protectors</b>	Jacket may be dark blue or black with white stock. Tweed jacket with coloured stock or collar and tie. Show jumping shirts, white stocks, white American collar or white shirts with collar and tie may be worn. A body protector is recommended, if worn, it should be fitted and worn as per the manufacturers' guidelines.
<b>Hair &amp; Jewellery</b>	No jewellery or any items worn in facial or body piercings are permitted. Hair must be neatly secured and MUST not hang lower than the shoulder line when standing normally
<b>Gloves</b>	Gloves are optional
<b>Whips</b>	MUST be between 45cm and 75cm and MUST not be weighted or with a hard point at the end
<b>Spurs</b>	Spurs are NOT permitted in Style Jumping Spurs of excessively severe design may not be worn; such designs include spurs with necks set to inside of heel, spurs with roughened/cutting edges and serrated spurs with or without necks. Spurs with smooth rowels not exceeding 1cm are allowed. Spurs may only be worn in the traditional manner, with the curve, if any, of the neck of the spur directed downwards. Spurs with necks up to 3cm are allowed.

At the discretion of the judge, competitors may be permitted to ride without jackets in excessively hot weather, but a suitable shirt that fastens at the neck (not bright or multi-coloured with a tie). American collar or correctly fastened stock must be worn. Shirts must have long sleeves. Plain, dark coloured waterproof coats may be worn in wet weather

<b>HORSE TRIALS &amp; CROSS COUNTRY</b>	
<b>Hat</b>	MUST wear a hard hat to at least the minimum standard, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Hats marked EN1384, PASO15:1998, ASTM F1163, BSEN14572:2005 or SEI. American standard SNELL E2001, ASTM 95, SNZ3838 1998. Skullcap hats must be worn with a silk. Fixed peaks are not permitted for cross country
<b>Jodhpurs &amp; Breeches</b>	White, cream or beige breeches or jodhpurs
<b>Boots</b>	Plain black or brown which may also be top boots or jodhpur boots. The boots should be a traditional style. Gaiters may be worn providing they are of identical leather to the boots and have no decoration of any sort
<b>Jackets, Shirts &amp; Body Protectors</b>	Sweatshirt or shirt. Hunting stock is recommended for safety. A body protector approved to Class 3 (Purple label) MUST be worn and should be fitted and worn as per the manufacturers' guidelines.
<b>Hair &amp; Jewellery</b>	No jewellery or any items worn in facial or body piercings are permitted. Hair must be neatly secured and MUST not hang lower than the shoulder line when standing normally
<b>Gloves</b>	Gloves are recommended
<b>Whips</b>	MUST be between 45cm and 75cm and MUST not be weighted or with a hard point at the end
<b>Spurs</b>	Spurs of excessively severe design may not be worn; such designs include spurs with necks set to inside of heel, spurs with roughened/cutting edges and serrated spurs with or without necks. Spurs with smooth rowels not exceeding 1cm are allowed. Spurs may only be worn in the traditional manner, with the curve, if any, of the neck of the spur directed downwards. Spurs with necks up to 3.5cm are allowed.
<b>Watches</b>	Watches capable of being started and recording time elapsed are FORBIDDEN in one day and cross country events only. Competitors are NOT permitted to take mobile phones onto the course when competing. No receiving, recording, transmitting or monitoring device may be used by a competitor during any phase in an competition
<b>Medical Armbands</b>	Medical armbands are compulsory
